What makes a successful entry?

- Review the list of categories and choose which awards you would apply for.
- Read the specific entry criteria for the award category.
- Assigning a different category and criteria to people in your team may be useful in covering their specialism.
- In order to solidify your choice, have answers to why the nominee should be nominated and what impact they have had to be nominated.

• Prepare any testimonials or quotes from patients or colleagues to support you nomination.

CATEGORIES

Category: Above and Beyond General Practice-Individual/Team

Criteria: Team/individual that demonstrated awareness of patient outcome and well-being. Shows qualities of organisation, leadership and efficiencies.

Category: Above and Beyond Community Pharmacy-Individual/Team

Criteria: Team/individual that demonstrated awareness of patient outcome and well-being. Shows qualities of organisation, leadership and efficiencies.

Category: Above and Beyond Partnership - Individual/Team

Criteria: Recognise organisations which have made progress working together. Looking for evidence of strong collaborative partnership which leads to demonstrable outcomes.

The entry could focus on how a specific service or patient cohort has benefitted from a partnership.

Category: Health Innovation - Individual/Team

Criteria: Project designed and produced built on strong local partnerships. Demonstrate measurable impact outlining what has made a difference.

Hear from teams who are doing something new while building good practice.

Category: Well-Being Champion/Workforce Well-Being - Individual/Team Criteria: Looking for examples of positive working culture/environment.

Category:Fellowships Individual

Criteria: Individuals that demonstrated compassion and leadership qualities with actionable plans for change and improved patient care whilst putting new skills into practice.

Category: Award for Leadership - Individual

Criteria: Nominate someone in your team/line manager who has showed excellent leadership in the past year and inspires you to be the best you can be.

Category: Education and Training Champion - Individual

Criteria: Individuals driving the training and help embed training in the culture of their teams and beyond, working towards improving the workforce experience and retention. Leaders with the desire, ability, and discipline to train others, lead training efforts and support those they teach.

Category: Equality, Diversity and Inclusion- Voice for Change- Individual

Criteria: Voice for Change | Criteria: Individuals disseminate information and best practice, raise awareness of equality and diversity issues, encourage involvement in initiatives and help promote a culture where workforce is treated fairly and with dignity and respect. demonstrating exceptional commitment to the promotion of diversity and inclusion in primary care, supporting more inclusive experience for workforce or patients.


Category: Aspiring Champion and Leaders for the Future- Individual
