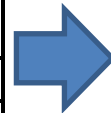
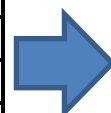

Two-Level DVT Wells Score		
Clinical Feature	Points	Score
Active Cancer (treatment ongoing, within 6/12 or palliative).	1	
Paralysis, paresis or recent plaster immobilisation of the lower limb.	1	
Localised tenderness along the distribution of the deep vein system.	1	
Recently bedridden for 3 days or more or major surgery within 12 weeks requiring general or regional anaesthesia.	1	
Entire leg swollen	1	
Calf swelling at least 3cms larger than asymptomatic leg.	1	
Pitting oedema confined to the symptomatic leg.	1	
Collateral/dilated superficial veins (non-varicose).	1	
Previously documented DVT.	1	
An alternative diagnosis is at least as likely as DVT.	-2

**Wells' score 2 or more
(high risk)**

**Steps
(same day appointment @DVT clinic)**

Contact the DVT clinic on # 6216 to arrange appointment for further assessment +/- Doppler scan.

Copy of completed GP referral proforma to be given to the patient to hand to the DVT clinic nurse .

Patient attends DVT clinic (same day).

OR

**Steps
(non-same day appointment)**

If scan can NOT be completed on the same day. Then supply treatment dose anticoagulation (minimum 3 day supply).

Copy of completed GP referral proforma to be given to the patient to hand to the DVT clinic nurse.

Patient attends DVT clinic within 3 days.

Refer patient to UTC with completed proforma. For fast track (POCT) D.Dimer.& baseline bloods
