## Implementation of Advice & Refer (A&R) in Gynaecology

BHRUT is undertaking a major programme with primary care partners, commissioners, and our patients to transform the way we deliver outpatient services.

A significant part of the overall programme is to optimise care pathways. We are changing the way GPs refer a patient to BHRUT Gynaecology services to a process known as 'advice and refer' (A&R) using the advice and guidance (A&G) pathway on e-RS.

A&R provides primary care with continued access to timely specialist clinical advice and triage, enabling a patient's care to be managed in the most appropriate setting, strengthening shared decision making and avoiding unnecessary outpatient appointments.

As of **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2024**, all referrals for gynaecology should be sent to:

## Gynaecology - Advice & Refer Service - Queens Hospital and King George Hospital RF4 - BHRUT

BHRUT will be closing other referral pathways for the General Gynaecology clinic service resulting in a single streamlined electronic referral process for GPs seeking General Gynaecology clinic appointments or Advice & Guidance.

All requests will be reviewed within 5 working days - either to give prompt advice or to schedule an appointment, according to clinical need.

Please note, 2ww and Fertility clinics will be excluded from this change and will retain their existing separate referral pathway and process.
