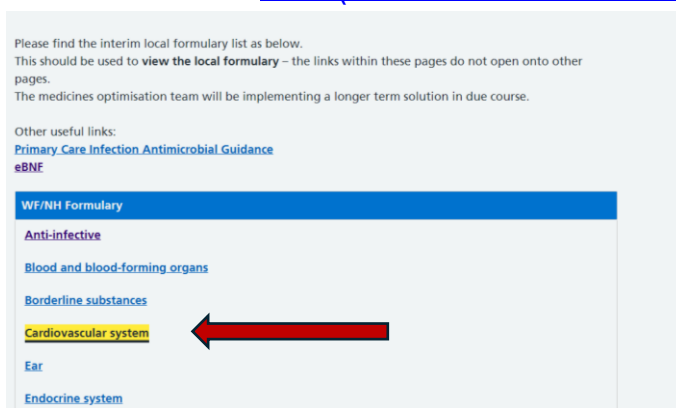


## Quick guide - How to use the formulary download information

Note: The formulary downloads are used **only to view** formulary status where the information is available. For any prescribing information e.g. indication, dosage etc. please refer to the BNF (NICE) [BNF \(British National Formulary\) | NICE](#)

1. Select the correct Place-based formulary
2. Select the Chapter the drug would be in e.g. Cardiovascular system. If you are unsure which chapter the drug is located in, please check the BNF via link [BNF \(British National Formulary\) | NICE](#)



3. Utilise the **CTR** + **F** function to search for the drug name within the downloads. Do not use the actual “search” box within the download – this does not work.
4. Please note the indication for which the drug is under e.g.

Cardiovascular system / **Hypertension**
