Please find attached out latest guidelines for management of Allergic conjunctivitis. We have seen a significant increase in patients with allergic symptoms being sent to A&E.

Regrettably we do not have capacity to see non urgent conditions and we are unable to book these in as emergencies.

Our most used topical drugs are listed on the leaflet. We are very happy for you to prescribe these for up to three months without a referral to the eye clinic.

Should patients require an eye clinic review, kindly send these as routine referrals to your local hospital eye service. I hope you find these guidelines useful.
