## North East London Recommended First Line Blood Glucose Test Strips (BGTS)

In line with NHS England (NHSE) commissioning recommendations, the 2024/25 NEL Prescribing Efficiency Scheme requires practices to prescribe from the following range of BGTS:

CareSens S testing strips	£	5.45
Contour Plus testing strips	£	5.95
Finetest Lite testing strips	£	5.95
Glucofix Tech Sensor testing strips*	£	5.95
True Metrix testing strips	£	5.95
GlucoRx Q testing strips	£	5.45
On Call Extra testing strips	£	5.20

#### Mesalazine (Asacol®) MR 400mg gastro-resistant tablets - discontinued

Asacol® is now discontinued in all strengths aside from 800mg MR see here for more information

NEL ICB are advising practices to prescribe the formulary first line choice Octasa® which has availability in all strengths. Prescribing as Octasa® will support patient supply following the ongoing discontinuation of Asacol®.

#### BNF: Dose equivalence and conversion for mesalazine

There is no evidence to show that any one oral preparation of mesalazine is more effective than another; however, the delivery characteristics of oral mesalazine preparations may vary and should be prescribed by brand to avoid confusion.
