The event is being organised through One Voice Network (OVN) and National AIDS Trust's (NAT) *Unheard Voices* project. *Unheard Voices* aims to address and dismantle the structural inequalities that impact the health and wellbeing of Black people living with or at risk of HIV in the UK. The project strengthens community leadership and co-design in the HIV response by building evidence, developing skills, and fostering meaningful connections with decision-makers.

This important report is the result of extensive engagement with community members, healthcare professionals, and advocates, and highlights urgent areas for action to improve equity, trust, and quality of care. The launch event will bring together people with lived experience, clinicians, commissioners, policymakers, and community leaders to reflect on the findings and begin a collective conversation about the next steps. The programme will include presentations and speeches highlighting key findings and recommendations of the report.

We are honoured to be inviting speakers including **Professor Jane Anderson, Dr Aneesha Noonan**, and others to form part of the panel. The event will be chaired by **Reverend Jide Macaulay**, with time after for informal networking and discussion.
