1. Upcoming webinars reminder: Choosing Your PoC supplier for autumn/winter 2025 COVID and flu vaccination campaign – FOR INFORMATION AND ACTION

To cascade to community pharmacy sites.

Community pharmacy vaccination sites must use one of the assured Point of Care (PoC) systems to record vaccinations for the AW25 COVID-19 and Seasonal Flu vaccination programmes. This provision is now commissioned under a national contract with suppliers, eliminating the need for regional local commissioning.

Successfully awarded PoC providers are undergoing assurance, with five expected to be certified for recording both Flu and COVID-19 vaccinations. Progress can be viewed here: [Community pharmacy - NHS England Digital](#)

2. Important: User Access and Deactivation Guidance for RAVS - **FAO: RAVS Site Lead Admins**

Please ensure that appropriate checks are in place before deactivating any user accounts. Specifically, Site Lead Admins should **confirm that a user is no longer employed by the organisation** before removing their access from RAVS to help ensure continuity and minimise disruption.

A few important reminders:

- Site admin users have the ability to add, deactivate, and reactivate users as needed within their organisation [Managing users - NHS Record a vaccination](#)
- 90-Day Inactivity Rule: Any account that has not been accessed in **90 days** will be automatically deactivated. Site Lead Admins can reactivate users at any time.
- As we prepare for the Autumn/Winter 2025 (AW25) season, all users are encouraged to log in regularly to ensure their account remains active.
