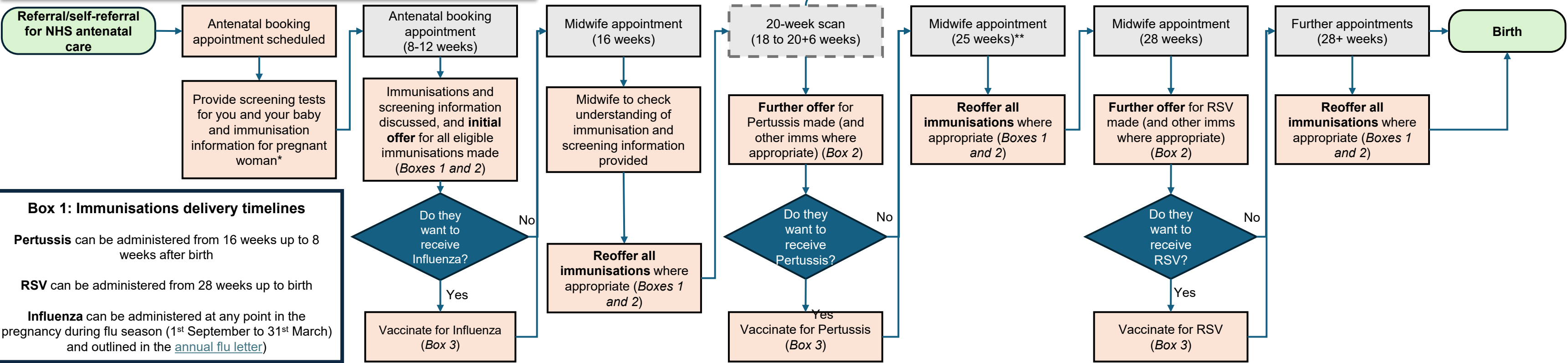
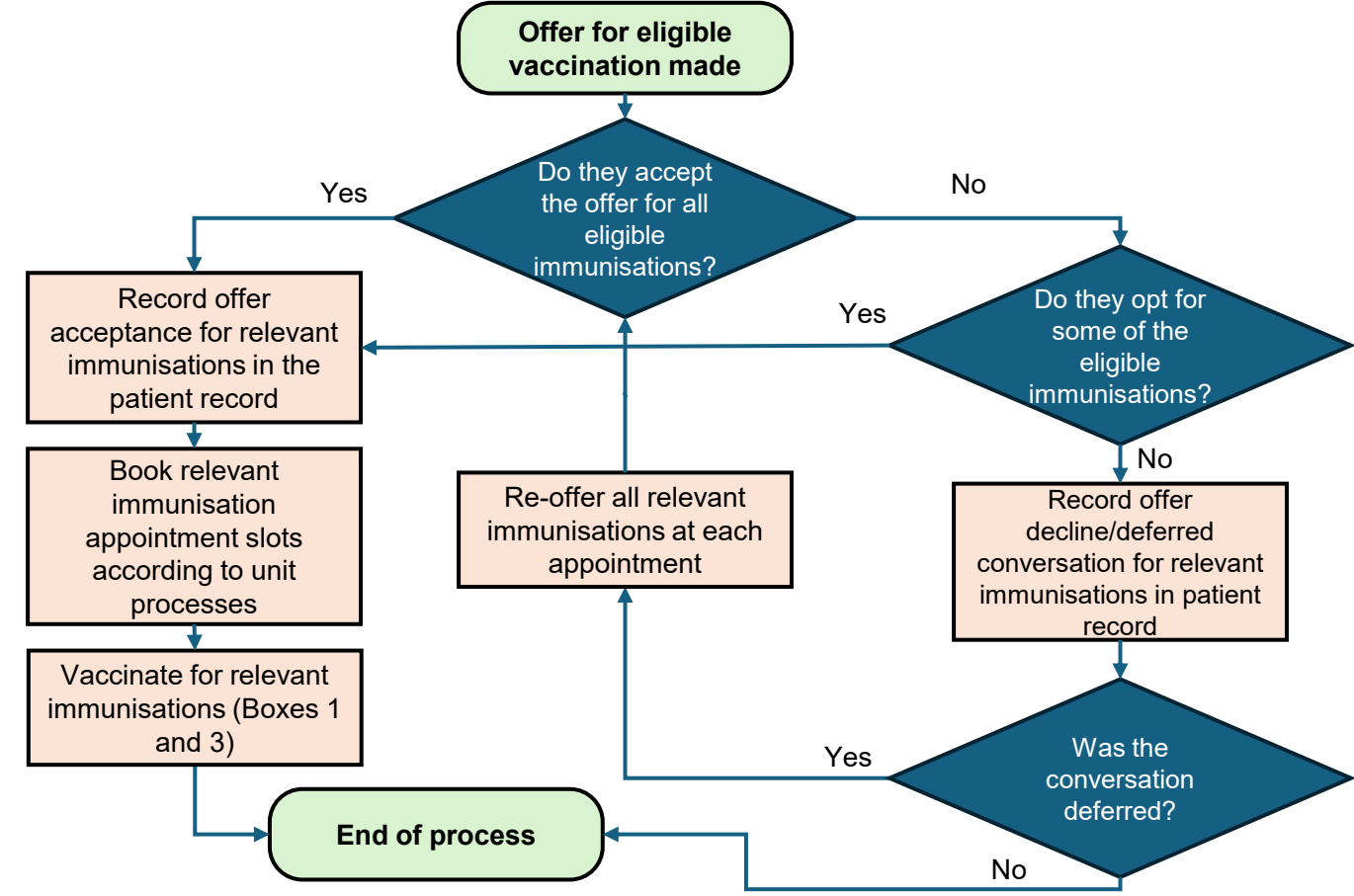


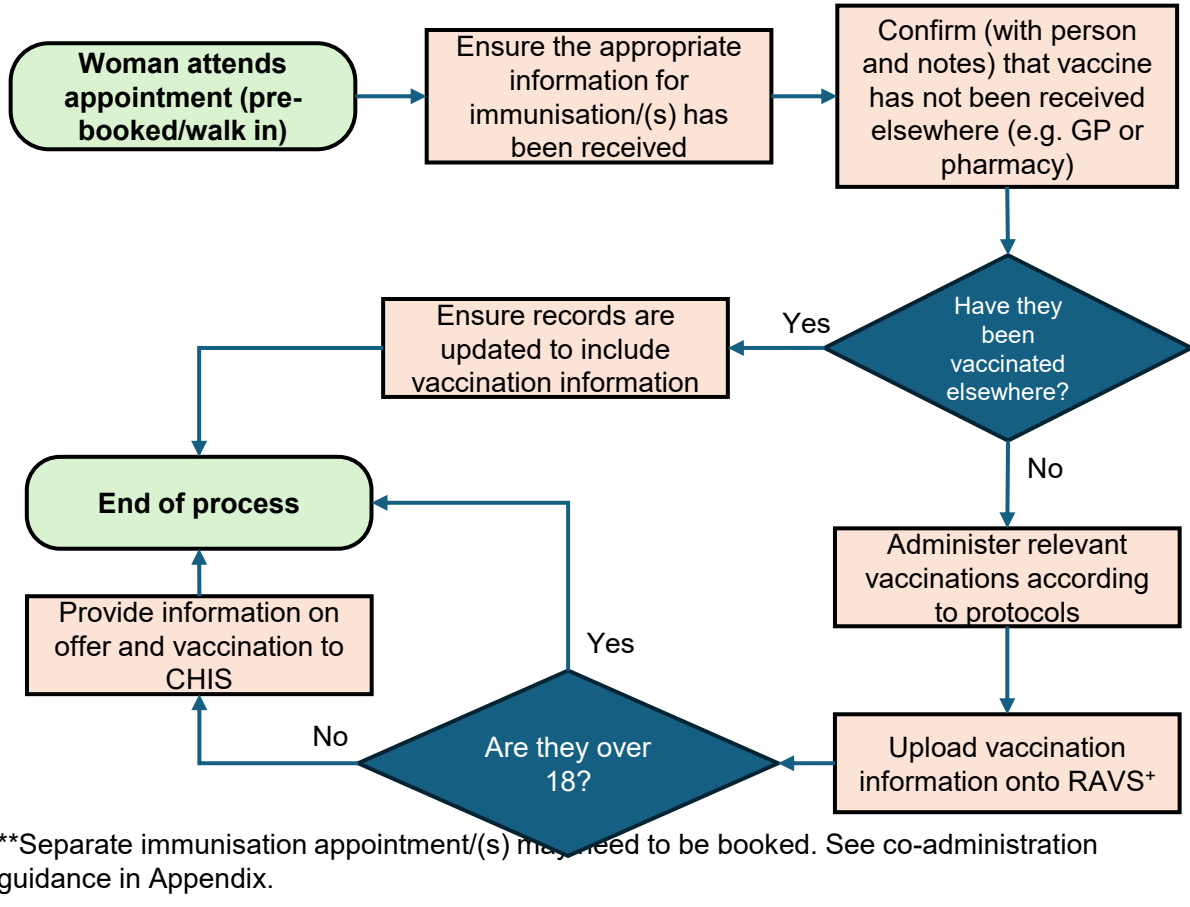

**Box 3: Maternity vaccination process**

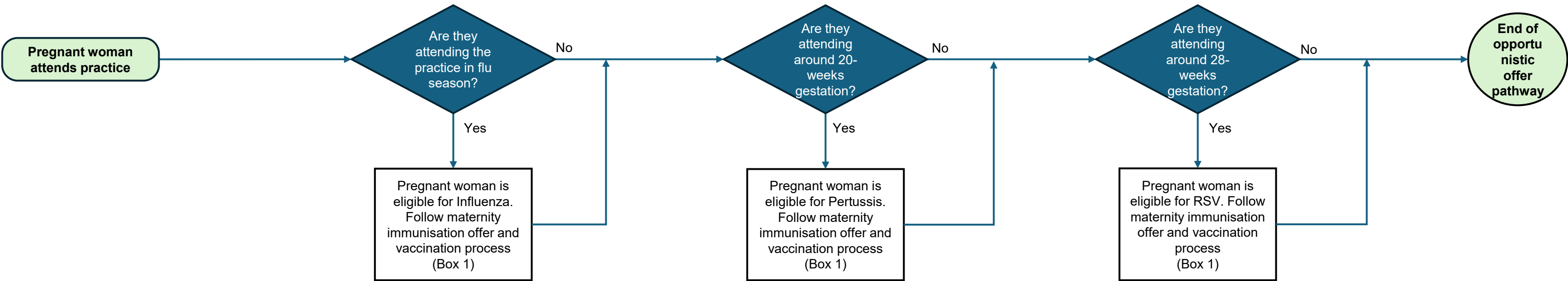

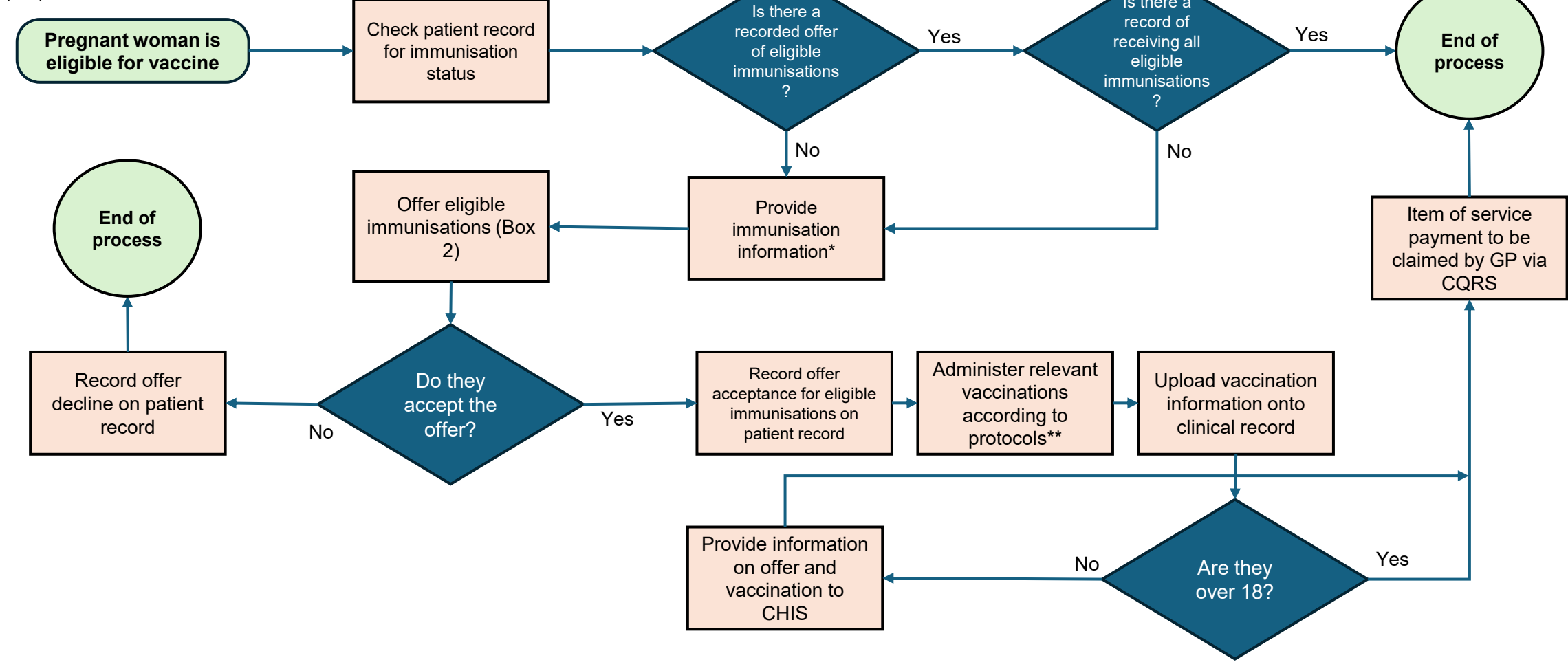

## Box 2: Immunisations delivery timelines

**Pertussis** can be administered from 16 weeks up to 8 weeks after birth

**RSV** can be administered from 28 weeks up to birth

**Influenza** can be administered at any point in the pregnancy during flu season (1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> March) and outlined in the [annual flu letter](#))

## Key information for primary care

- Ensure you have sufficient vaccine stock to enable opportunistic offers
- Ensure appropriate immunisation information is provided around **all vaccinations at all visits**
- *Where possible immunisation information should be provided as a leaflet (leaflets can be ordered [here](#)).*
