- Central Training & Support
- Commissioned training for potential Primary Care Nursing preceptors and advocates, equipping them with leadership and mentoring skills.
- Comprehensive Framework
- A clear programme structure outlining delivery frequency, responsibilities, and expectations, including standardised job descriptions and person specifications for preceptors/advocates.
- Engagement & Recruitment Process
- Programme promotion across PCNs with an Expression of Interest (EOI) process for potential preceptors/advocates, ensuring fair and transparent selection.
- Inclusive Participation
- Support for all PCN practices to sign up and benefit from the scheme.
- Supervisor Training
- A dedicated training programme for supervisors to strengthen oversight and quality assurance.
- Financial Support
 - o Grant allocation based on a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for each PCN.
 - Funding to cover preceptor/advocate sessions, with flexibility for these roles to work across multiple PCNs.
- Programme Management
- Led by the Head of Primary Care Nursing, supported by senior place-based nurses and administrative staff for smooth delivery.
- Multi-Year Innovation

<u>Legacy Nurse Mentor Programme</u>

Do any of your nursing team want clinical support? Maybe they would like to enhance their Long Term Condition Management? Maybe they would like to develop confidence in a particular skill? Maybe they would like the opportunity for peer to peer support?

The Legacy Nurse Mentoring Programme has a team of highly experienced and knowledgeable mentors who will be available to come into clinics to support, collaborate with and develop the primary care nursing workforce. These Legacy Nurse mentors are available to provide a maximum of 6 sessions over 6 months per mentee. This will be based on the needs of the mentee and at the mentors discretion.

These programmes of work are a strategic investment in primary care nurse leadership, designed to demonstrate the benefits of professional preceptorship, mentorship and advocacy. By participating, your PCN will help shape a neighbourhood model of care, ensuring primary care nurses have the leadership support they need to thrive.
