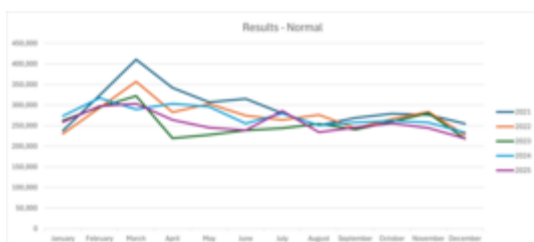
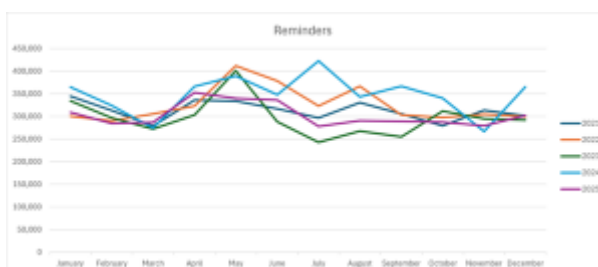


#### Invitations

A total of 543,840 invitations communications were sent in December 2025 compared to 369,049 sent in November 2025. An increase of 174,791. Of the total invitation and reminder communications sent, invitations accounted for 64.32%.

## **Reminders**

December 2025 saw 301,718 reminder communications sent. This was an increase of 22,512 on the previous month. Reminders accounted for 35.68% of the total invitation and reminder communications sent in December.

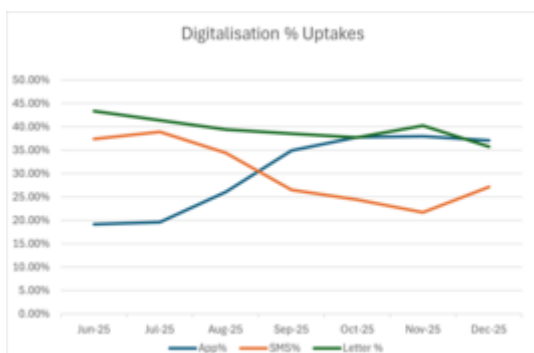


## **Results-Normal**

The number of normal results communications sent out in December 2025 decreased by 24,846 on November's figure to 219,229. Normal results communications accounted for 19.90% of all communications sent in December 2025.

## **Results-Abnormal**

CSAS sent a total of 13,171 abnormal result communications in the month of December 2025. Abnormal results communications account for 5.67% of all results communications and 1.20% of all communications sent in December 2025.



## **Digitalisation of Cervical Screening Communications**

Abnormal results continue to be the only communication not sent via the NHS App. In December 2025 the uptake figures are as follows;

**NHS App: 37.06%**

**SMS: 27.11%**

**Letter: 35.78%**

## **Information / Update**

### **Message for GP Practice Colleagues**

Following an audit on patients who have been removed from the Cervical Screening Programme in error, it was identified that there has been an increase in ceasing errors occurring via the CSMS Prior Notification List (PNL)/Non-Responder electronic submissions, predominantly for the reason of 'No cervix'.

Please can GP practice colleagues ensure they validate their cease submissions to reduce the risk of errors, which could result in patients being permanently removed from the Cervical Screening Programme inappropriately.

313 patients have been reinstated following the last audit in June 2025. The following methods were used to cease the patients inappropriately:

- 26% - Ad-hoc cease request forms submitted to CSAS
- 71% - Cease requests submitted electronically via the Prior Notification Lists and Non-Responder Lists within the Cervical Screening Management System (CSMS)
- The remaining 3% were linked to an incorrect date of birth recorded on the Spine, which automatically ceased the patients' recalls due to age

### **Manual Matching Figures**

Below are the manual matching figures for December 2025 relating to:

- London Laboratory
- National

'Non hits' are where participants details do not match an active record within CSMS

.

**The sample taker is responsible for making sure that the sample and request submitted relate to the correct person. It is essential that the sample taker checks with the individual that:**

- **their details on the downloaded request form are correct**
- **their correspondence address is current**
- **the personal details relate to them and are correct (such as their full name and date of birth)**

**If the address is not current, an address amendment should be submitted, via the GP links by the practice, of the new details as soon as possible. This will prevent downloaded results from laboratories being rejected or correspondence sent to the wrong address.**

**The sample taker is responsible for making sure that the person is contactable so they can be advised of any further tests or investigations needed following screening.**
