

CPD Course: ISEP Environmental Sustainability Skills for the Workforce

As part of the **NHS North East London Integrated Care System** environmental sustainability and net zero journey, we are offering all staff a continuing professional development (CPD) course on **Environmental Sustainability Skills for the Workforce**. This a two day environmental awareness course aimed at non-environmental specialists, delivered by teams from Barking, Havering, and Redbridge University Hospitals NHS Trust (BHRUT), Barts Health NHS Trust, NELFT and NHS North East London.

This course is perfect for those working in any job role across all sectors, to ensure that environmental sustainability is embedded into all job roles of a company.

The course covers the main environmental risks and opportunities facing organisations; the importance of resource efficiency; the impacts of pollution, prevention, control and legislation; the impact of transport; and knowing how employees can support environmental sustainability.

The sessions are delivered **online via MS Teams**, on the following dates:

Tutors: Rebecca Waters (Anchors and Net Zero Manager, NHS North East London) and Samuel Wood (Sustainability and Net Zero Manager, Barts Health).

Trainers delivering this course are accredited by ISEP, have recent relevant experience in the environmental/sustainability sector and demonstrate technical competence in this area.

Key Features of the Course

- **Open to All:** This course is suited for all job roles and sectors and has no formal entry requirements.
- **Concise Format:** A focused session designed for those looking to gain baseline knowledge on net zero.
- **Materials:** Learners receive structured Learner Workbooks and a presentation.
- **Assessment:** To gain a certificate you will need to complete a 30-minute online assessment.
- **Certification:** ISEP certificate is provided to learners who successfully pass the assessment.

There are four Learning Outcomes for this course which are as follows:

1. The main environmental and economic risks and opportunities
2. Understanding of compliance obligations and business drivers for change
3. Understanding of the main potential impacts on environment and sustainability
4. Knowledge and understanding of how to improve environmental performance.
