1. GP Sign-Up - Flu vaccination service participation now available on CQRS – **FOR ACTION**

CQRS is now open for participation in the Adult and Children's Flu Vaccination Enhanced Services, and providers will be able to proceed with sign-up once the participation invite is issued. This option is expected to be available to practices on or before Wednesday 8 July.
